



The Department of Social Sciences and History (FB02) at TU Darmstadt is seeking to fill a position of

Full Professor (W3) in Modern History: Urban/Environmental History

The position is to be filled on 1st of April, 2020.

The successful candidate will teach Modern History (18th to 21st centuries) and Urban and Environmental History in all programmes taught at the Institute of History (BA History with a focus on Modernity, Joint BA, MA History, History for Teachers at secondary schools, MA of Education). It is expected that she/he will take active part in the further development of these programmes (in particular the planned interdisciplinary MA "Urban Studies").

The successful candidate has to have an excellent track record in at least one of the two areas of Urban and Environmental History and should be willing and be able to teach in the other. She/He should contribute to at least one other key area of research of the department. Research perspectives beyond Europe or in theory or methodology of history would be an advantage.

We expect a readiness to collaborate with colleagues, also beyond the range of the Humanities and Social Sciences. We expect experiences from the acquisition of external funding. Participation in academic administrative work is of importance.

Apart from having produced an excellent Ph.D. thesis and additional scholarly achievements (habilitation or equivalent accomplishments), candidates should be able to present innovative contributions in research and teaching in the focal points of the advertised chair.

The position is tenured with a remuneration package commensurate with experience and qualifications, following the German "W-Besoldung" and subject to negotiations between the applicant and the university directorate. The regulations for employment are specified under §§ 61 and 62 HHG (Hessisches Hochschulgesetz).

The Technische Universität Darmstadt intends to increase the number of female faculty members and encourages female candidates to apply. In case of equal qualifications applicants with a degree of disability of at least 50 or equal will be given preference.
