

## **Statement of candidacy for the Role of Regional Representative for Italy European Society for Environmental History – Elections 2019**

I am very pleased that certain distinguished Italian environmental historians have asked me to stand at the ESEH elections for the role of Regional Representative for Italy, since I have been working in the field of environmental history from the start of my academic career.

In Italy, environmental history still has a relatively low academic status; nevertheless, there is a strong and widespread interest in such a discipline, both within the academic community and more broadly. If I am elected to this role, I will continue the work of my former Regional Representatives in order to consolidate a network among scholars interested in the discipline, thanks to the newsletter already in circulation, to which a website could be added.

I would also like to encourage cooperation among the group members, not only through information exchange but also through providing opportunities to meet in person by organising meetings, seminars and workshops in which to discuss ongoing studies. Finally, I would like to promote dialogue between our network and other networks, both internationally (with other ESEH regional groups or with international networks on environmental history) and domestically, initiating collaborations with other Italian historical societies (including Sis; Sisem; Sislav; Sismed; Sissco).
